This is the list of materials for a Snow E-Day. Below you will find different options for each subject. Please choose **ONE** from each subject to complete for you to be counted as present. Below is the checklist that you can fill out and turn in the next time your student comes to class. If you are not able to print off the checklist, please see below the directions for emailing it.

Math

- Practice your multiplication tables for 15 minutes
- Write detailed instructions on how to solve a math problem you're currently learning about (about a paragraph)
- Make a video showing how to solve a challenging problem
- Make up your own math assignment and solve the problems yourself (should have at least 9 problems)

Reading

- Read to someone for 20 minutes
- Write your own story (should be at least 7 sentences)
- Draw your favorite scene from a book you've read recently

Science/Social Studies

- Make a video or take pictures of you conducting an experiment of your choice

- Make up a new holiday and write a paragraph about it (a paragraph is 4-5 sentences)

PE

- If it is safe to do so, play for at least 15 minutes in the snow (dress warm!)
- Take a 15 minute nap
- Make up your own exercise routine, and write a list of what you did

Bible

- Act out your favorite bible story (take a picture)
- Pick a bible story and write a paragraph summary of it (a paragraph is 4-5 sentences)
- Memorize a verse with at least 20 words and be ready to recite it to me the next time you're back in school
- Write a paragraph explaining who your favorite person in the bible is and why
- Read a bible story to someone

Below is the checklist that you can use if you have a printer. Alternatively, you can email me to make sure your child is marked as present.

The email should include:

1. List of what you did for each subject
2. Pictures of any activities that require it
3. Pictures of any writing that was done for an assignment

Please note that the email needs to be sent either the day of the snow day or the day after. If it is sent any later than that, your student will be marked absent for that snow day.
