

Pre-K Snow Day Plans

Most important thing for today is to have fun playing in the snow! There is no required work, but if you would like some ideas for activities to keep your child busy, you can select one item from each section below to do for each snow day. Have your child circle the activity that they completed!

Reading

1. Have a family member read a story to you. Find a new story or maybe re-read your favorite!
2. Pick any letter of the alphabet. Find a magazine, newspaper or old piece of mail and circle words that begin with the letter you picked. Bonus: practice the letter in sign language also!
3. Tell a family member a Bible story you know, or have them read one to you. Practice acting it out together.

Writing

1. Pick any letter of the alphabet and practice writing the uppercase and lowercase version of it.
2. Practice drawing at least 4 different shapes.
3. Go outside and write your name in the snow!

Math

1. Walk in the snow and see how high you can count with every step you take.
2. Look at your calendar and count how many days are in the month.
3. Follow a recipe and make something in the kitchen with a family member. Talk about how you used math to cook.

For Fun!

1. What can you build in the snow? A snowman? A puppy dog? A castle? If you create something, have your parent send me a picture!
2. Ask a family member what you could do to be helpful for them. Be others-focused and do your best to help them out! When we come back to school, tell me how you helped.
3. Look out your window. What do you see? Use paints, or other colors to paint a picture.
