Read to an adult or older sibling.</p>	<p>Draw a picture of what you did on your snow day. Write at least one complete sentence to go with your picture.</p>	<p>Count to 100 by 10s and 1s. Too easy? See how high you can go! Option: See how many steps you can count yourself taking in the snow.</p>	<p>Fill one cup with snow and bring it inside. Fill another cup with ice. Which do you think will melt first?</p>
<p>Ask a family member to read you a Bible story. Make a picture about the story with details and color.</p>	<p>Have a family member read a fiction story to you. Choose your favorite character in the story, describe them. Then make a picture of the character.</p>	<p>Grab some paper and tape. Practice stretching out and writing words by going around your house and labeling eight things around the house.</p>	<p>Write numbers 1-20 . Make sure they are all correctly formed. Too easy? See how much higher you can write.</p>	<p>What can you build in the snow? A snowman? A fort? If you create something, have a parent send me a picture!</p>
<p>Have a family member help you write a prayer. Thank God for one thing, and ask Him for help with one thing. Decorate your prayer.</p>	<p>Have a family member read a nonfiction story to you. List at least three facts that you learned from the story.</p>	<p>Go outside and practice writing your name in the snow! Can your write the names of all your family members?</p>	<p>Go on a shape hunt! FInd 5 flat (2D) shapes and 5 solid (3D) shapes around your house.
